# The Prophet – The Prophecy

“The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your countrymen, you shall listen to him.” *Deuteronomy 18:15*

# The Prophet – The Fulfillment

“This is My beloved Son, with whom I  
am well-pleased; **listen to Him!**”

*Matthew 17:5*

# The Prophet – The Fulfillment

Therefore when the people saw the sign which He had performed, they said, “This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world.”

*John 6:14*

# Interpreted

“What do you think about the Christ, whose son is He? ”They said to Him, “*The son of David.*” He said to them, “Then how does David in the Spirit call Him ‘Lord,’ saying, ‘The Lord said to my Lord, “Sit at My right hand, until I put Your enemies beneath Your feet”’? If David then calls Him ‘Lord,’ how is He his son?”

# Jesus The Prophet

As “The Prophet,” Jesus is the ultimate revelation of God to man.

# A Priest – The Prophecy

The Lord has sworn and will not change His mind, “You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.” *Psalms 110:4*

# Priest – The Fulfillment

For every high priest taken from among men is appointed on behalf of men in things pertaining to God, in order to offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins; he can deal gently with the ignorant and misguided, since he himself also is beset with weakness; ...

# Priest – The Fulfillment

and because of it he is obligated to offer *sacrifices* for sins, as for the people, so also for himself. And no one takes the honor to himself, but *receives it* when he is called by God, even as Aaron was.

# A Priest – The Fulfillment

So also Christ did not glorify Himself so as to become a high priest, but He who said to Him, “You are My Son, today I have begotten You”; just as He says also in another *passage*, “You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.”

# Jesus our Mediator

For there is one God, *and* one mediator also between God and men, *the* man Christ Jesus.

*1 Timothy 2:5*



# Jesus our Intercessor

Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us.

*Romans 8:34*

# Jesus our Advocate

And if anyone sins, we have  
an Advocate with the Father, Jesus  
Christ the righteous.

*1 John 2:1*

# Our Accuser

Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, “Now the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren has been thrown down, he who accuses them before our God day and night.” *Revelation 12:10*

# Jesus our High Priest

“Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as *we are, yet* without sin. Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.” *Hebrews 4:14-16*

Jesus is our Mediator, Intercessor  
and Advocate.

# King – The Prophecy

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout *in triumph*, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; He is just and endowed with salvation, humble, and mounted on a donkey, even on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

# King – The Fulfillment

“Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we saw His star in the east and have come to worship Him.” *Matthew 2:2*

# King – The Fulfillment

Those who went in front and those who followed were shouting: “Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord; blessed *is* the coming kingdom kingdom of our father David; Hosanna in the highest!” *Mark 11:9-10*

# King – The Fulfillment

Now Jesus stood before the governor,  
and the governor questioned Him,  
saying, “Are You the King of the Jews?”  
And Jesus said to him, “*It is as you say.*”

*Matthew 27:11*

And above His head they put up the charge against Him which read, “THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS.”

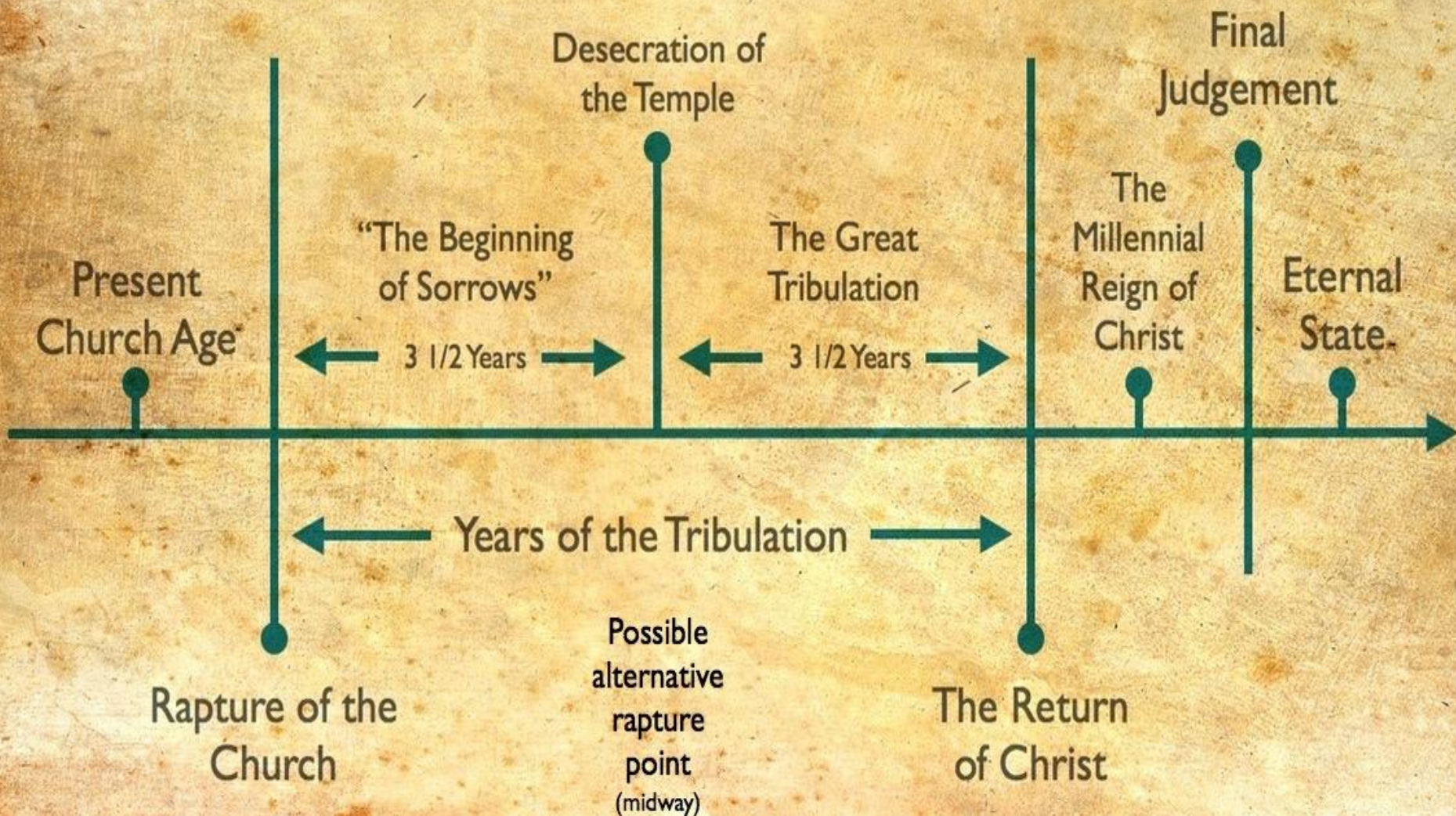
