

How to live life?

We need to be <u>flexible</u> and have an <u>open mind</u> as to how God may do things.

"Why do John's disciples and the disciples of the Pharisees fast, but Your disciples do not fast?"

ADVICE

Don't let anyone "should" on you.

"Look, why are they doing what is not lawful on the Sabbath?"

Mark 2:24

"They were watching Him to see if He would heal him on the Sabbath, so that they might accuse Him." Mark 3:2

The Problem

"You are mistaken, not understanding the Scriptures nor the power of God." *Matthew 22:29*

I will never desert you, nor will I ever forsake you. *Hebrew 13:5*

Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you at the proper time, casting all your anxiety on Him, because He cares for you." 1 Peter 5:6-7

Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. *James 4:8*

Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light. Matthew 11:28-30

Solution

We need to prayerfully ask God's Holy Spirit to lead us in the right application of the truth.

Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to Him *be* the glory...

Conviction is meant to <u>lift you up</u> while Condemnation is meant to tear you down.
