Mark Chapter 6

Jesus Verbs

When the Sabbath came, He began to teach in the synagogue; and the many listeners were astonished, saying, "Where did this man get these things, and what is this wisdom given to Him, and such miracles as these performed by His hands?

Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, and brother of James and Joses and Judas and Simon? Are not His sisters here with us?" And they took offense at Him.



Truth is <u>truth</u> regardless of <u>who</u> is speaking or teaching.

Mark 6:7-8a

And He summoned the twelve and began to send them out in pairs, and gave them authority over the unclean spirits; and **He instructed** them...

"Instruct" vs "Teach"

Compound Greek word "parangello."

para – beside angello – to announce

It literally means "to announce beside"

Matthew 28:18-20

"All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and **make disciples** of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

To be move by compassion

"splagchnizomai" (splänkh-nē'-zo-mī)


Are we willing to <u>love</u> people deeply like <u>Jesus</u> did?
